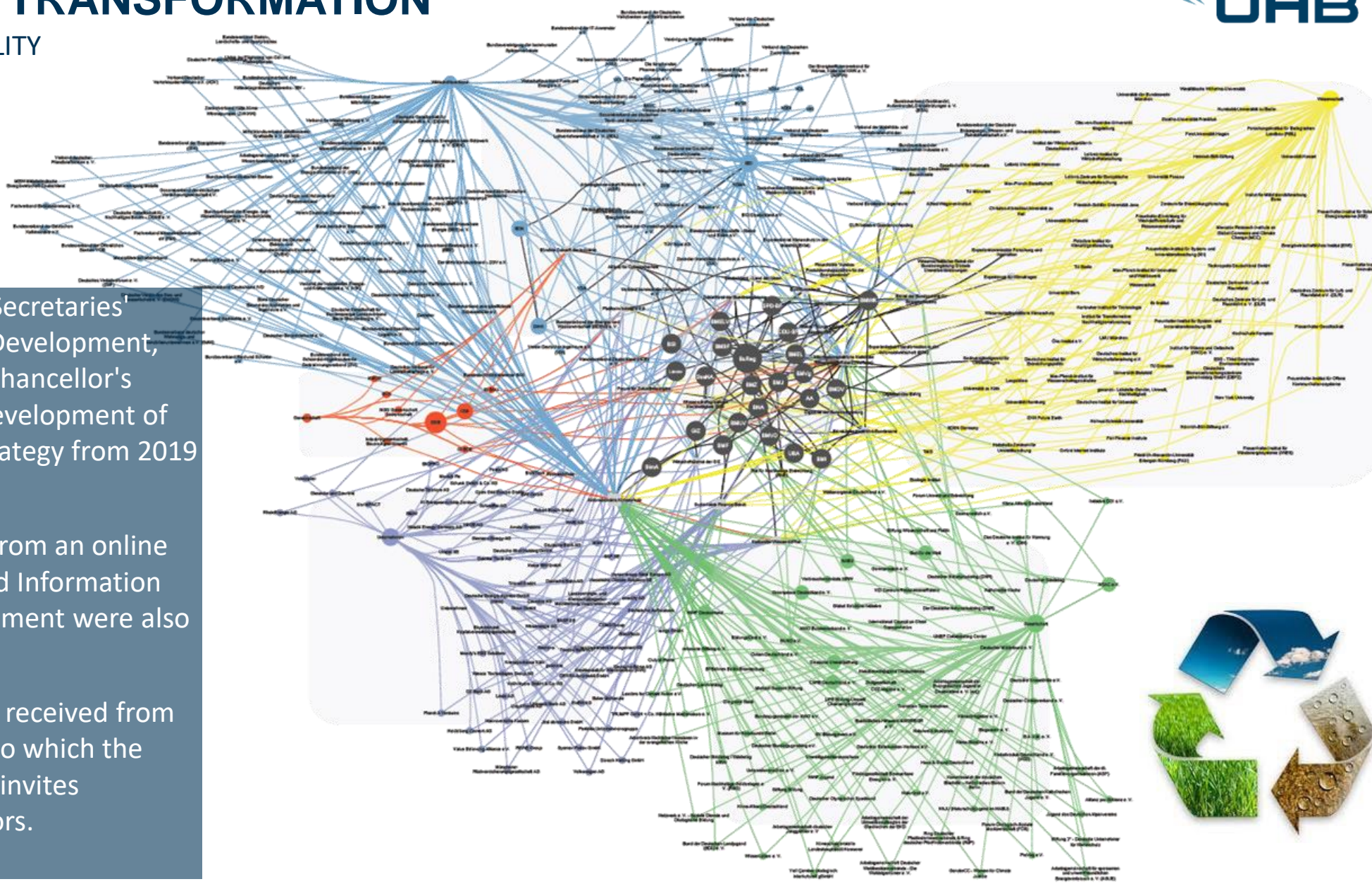
FACTS & FIGURES

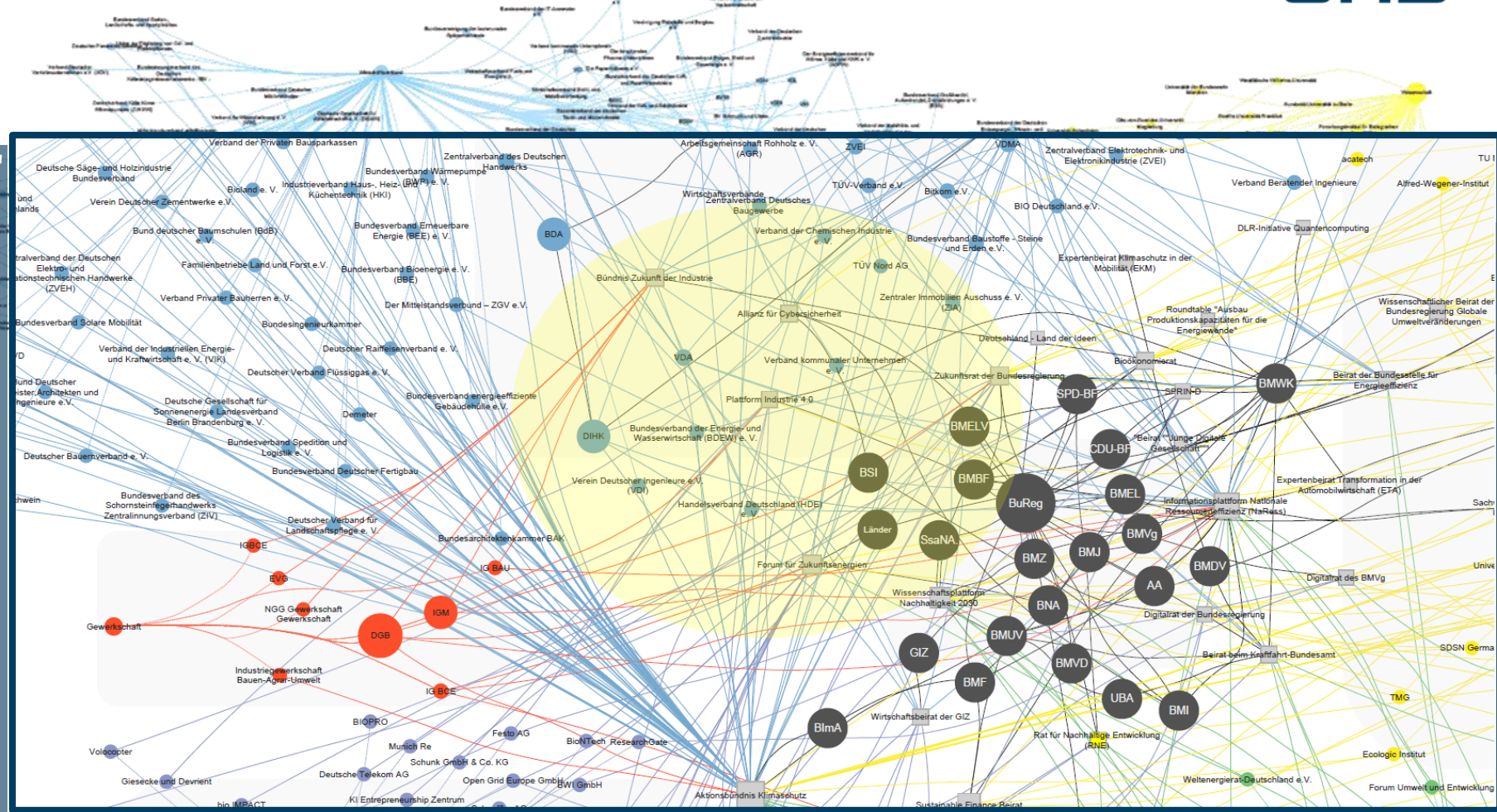

THE GERMAN SPACE LAW

A NECESSARY CONDITION FOR SUSTAINABILITY IN SPACE?



- Given the ever-increasing importance of space as an economic and living space, the sustainable use of space must go hand in hand with stronger regulation: without binding regulations on the handling of space debris, space traffic management and the peaceful use of space, Europe's ambitions in space will not be achievable.
- A German space law that focuses on the sustainable use of space can be based on the regulations in other countries, e.g. France, the United Kingdom or New Zealand: The space laws of these countries contain regulations on the design and operation of satellites that are specifically aimed at avoiding the creation of space debris.
- Ultimately, however, a German space law can only be one component of an international approach, otherwise there is a risk that German industry will be disadvantaged in international competition.
